He has also been associated with a number of committees set up by the central and state governments and by the RBI. He has authored numerous scholarly articles and books in the areas of macroeconomics and public finance and policy. As a noted economist, he continues to be consulted for his inputs to India's economic policy making. He is also the author of the EY Economy Watch, a monthly thought leadership publication capturing the macro-fiscal developments in the Indian Economy.
